# What is FLIGHT?

FLIGHT is our 30-minute activity period

During FLIGHT you can:

- Get extra help from teachers
- Reassess work/tests
- Complete make-up work
- Study
- Participate in clubs & activities
- Meet with coaches
- Meet with counselors

# Why between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> block?

We are committed to offering Flight each day

- This schedule prioritizes Flight

CTE students who travel off-site, early dismissal students, and dual enrollment students can participate

When we returned from Covid, feedback from students and staff supported a break in instruction for our students

- AM break for Flight and PM break for Lunch

Can run on a two-hour late arrival or two-early dismissal day





# How does FLIGHT work?

- 9:30-10:00 am the entire school “breaks” for FLIGHT.
- Students will follow a set schedule of classes during FLIGHT.
- Will start with extra class engagement on September 13th.
- All students must be in a designated classroom each day.
- September 13<sup>th</sup> is an A day. The schedule will begin with 1A being the first FLIGHT day.
- September 14<sup>th</sup> is a B day we will have FLIGHT for 1B
- September 15<sup>th</sup>, students will move to 2A class and have FLIGHT for 2A for 30 minutes before moving to class.

# Phase 1 and Phase 2

- The first phase Flight will focus on academic success
  - We will follow the set schedule as discussed in the previous slide
- In phase 2, we will begin academic clubs and activities, students will meet during the teacher planning block.
  - For example: the teacher has 2a planning, they will meet with their group during 2a Flight time.
- Students will be issued passes to activities by their sponsor to meet during their designated times.
- We try to have all clubs/activities meet during Flight.

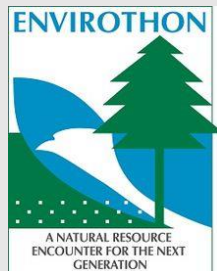
